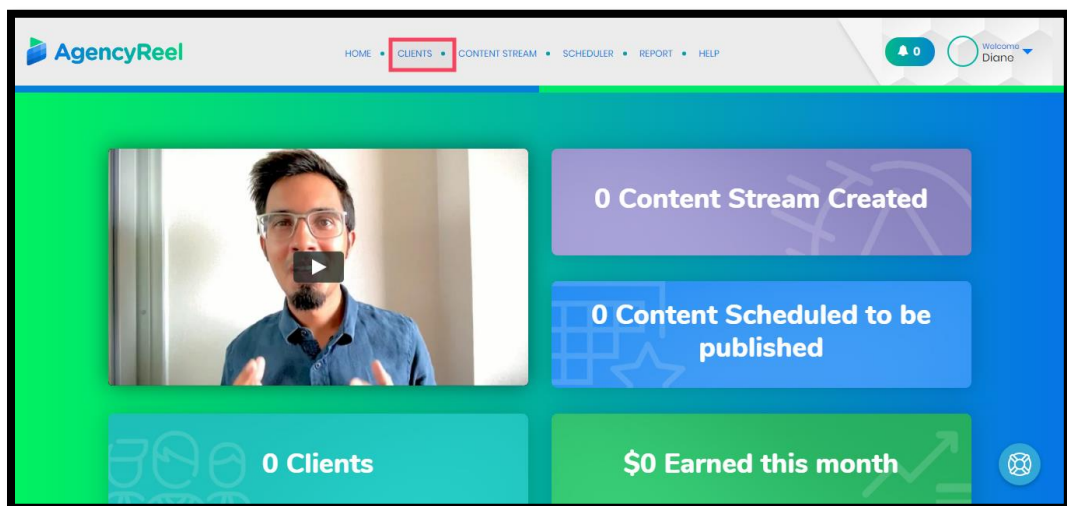
AGENCYREEL TUTORIAL- How to Connect Social accounts

How to Connect Facebook

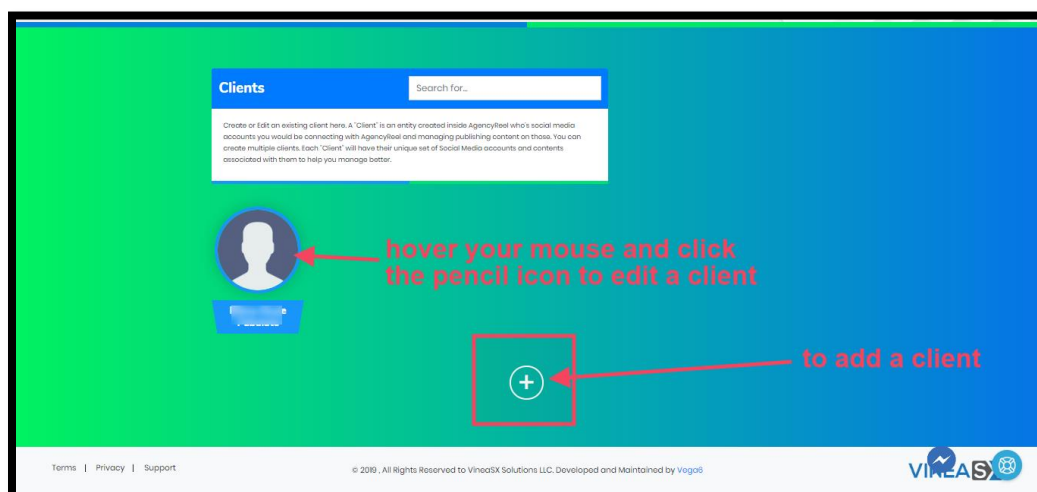
Connecting Facebook to AgencyReel will let you post your image and videos to your Facebook pages and groups whose you have admin right.

Follow these simple steps below:

On the dashboard, click on the Clients tab.



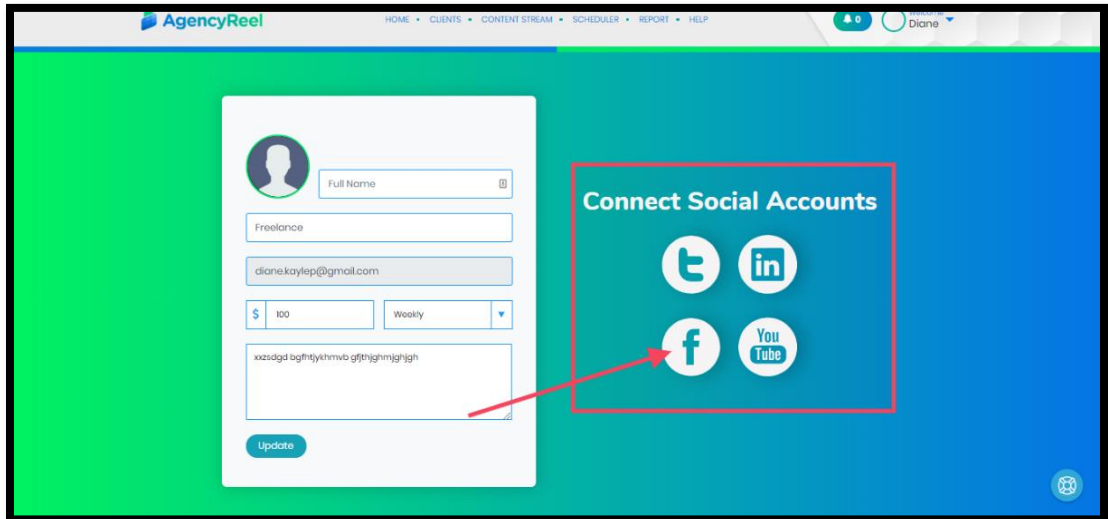
If you want to add a client then connect a social media account to it, click on the big Plus sign. But if you'd like to edit an existing client, hover your mouse then click on the Edit icon.



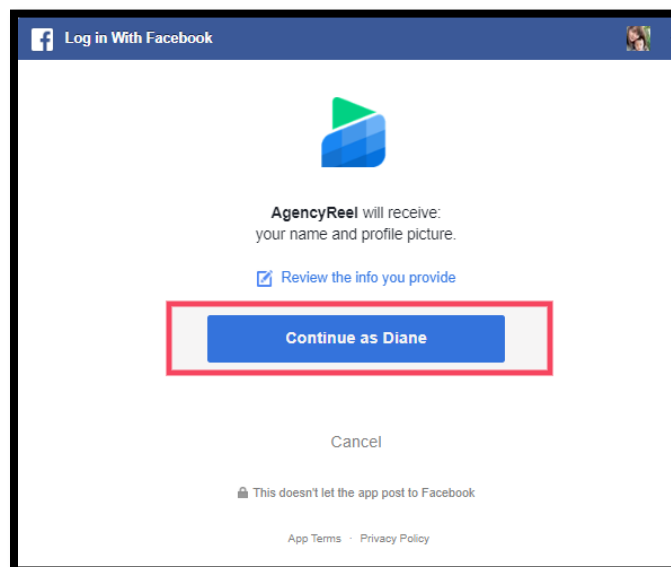

To connect Facebook, click the Facebook icon.

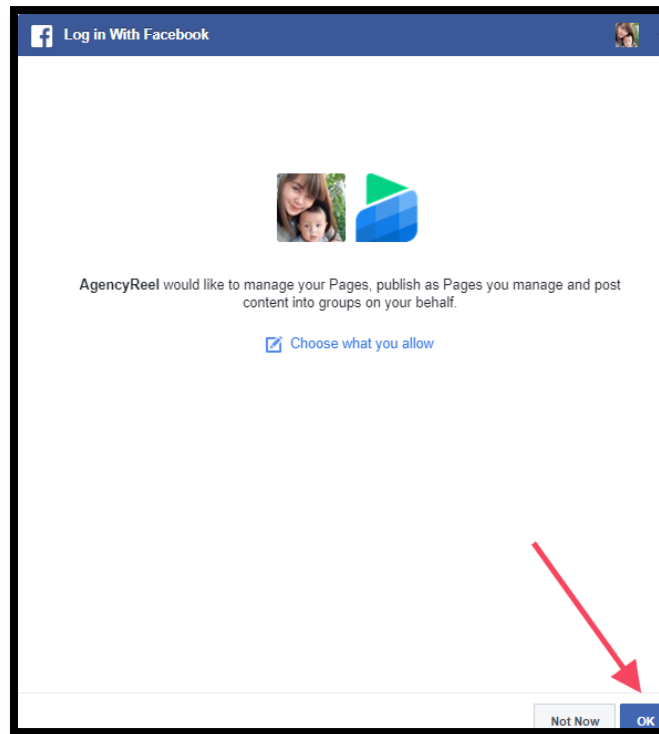


There will be a pop-up asking you to log in to your Facebook account. Once you've logged in, click on "Continue as Name" to allow AgencyReel to access your Facebook account. After that, click OK.

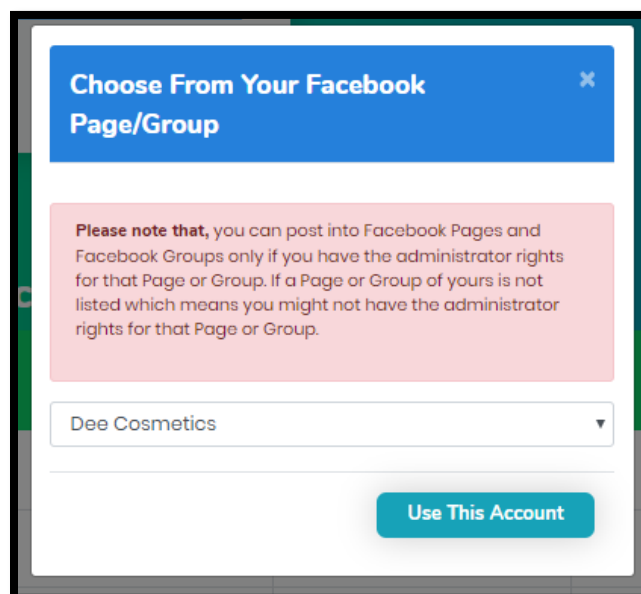

Choose the Facebook pages /group you'd like to integrate with AgencyReel. Once done, click on use this Account.

Now, after connecting your Facebook page or group you can publish your content (texts, images and videos) to your Facebook page provided you have admin rights to that page. In order to publish content on Facebook group, you have to go to your Group settings and add the AgencyReel app to that group. Follow the below steps to get this done.

To add an app to your group:

1. From your News Feed, click **Groups** in the left menu and select your group.
2. Click **...More** below your cover photo and select **Edit Group Settings**.
3. Next to Apps, click **Add Apps**.
4. Select the app you'd like to add to the group and click **Add**.
5. Click **Done**.

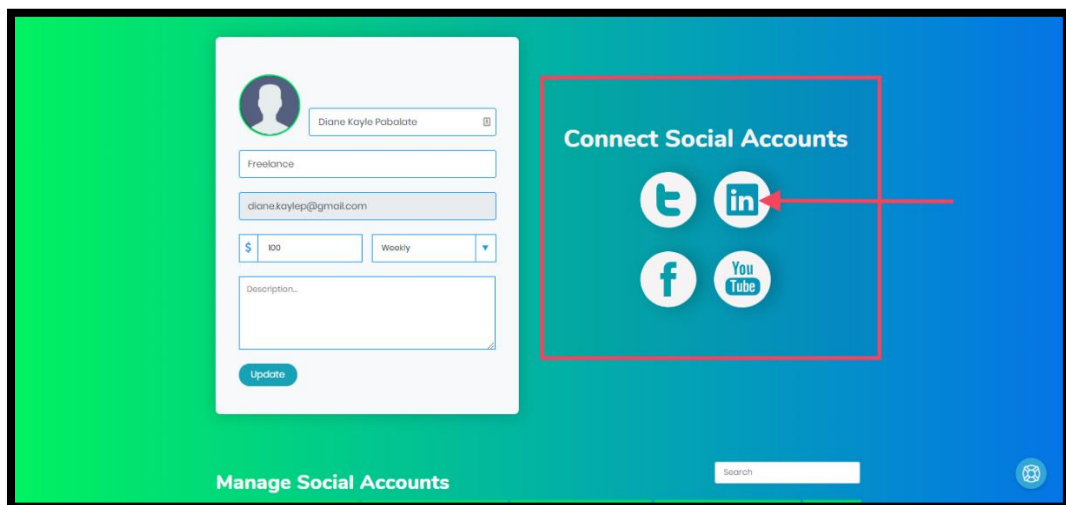
To remove an app from your group:

1. From your News Feed, click **Groups** in the left menu and select your group.
2. Click **More** below your cover photo and select **Edit Group Settings**.
3. Next to **Apps**, click **Manage Apps**.
4. Click **Remove** next to the app you'd like to remove and then click **Remove**.

Note that to connect multiple Facebook accounts; you need to connect it individually.

How to Connect LinkedIn

To connect LinkedIn, click the LinkedIn icon.



Log in to your LinkedIn account. Once done, there will be a pop-up asking you to enter a code for security purposes. The code will be sent to your email.

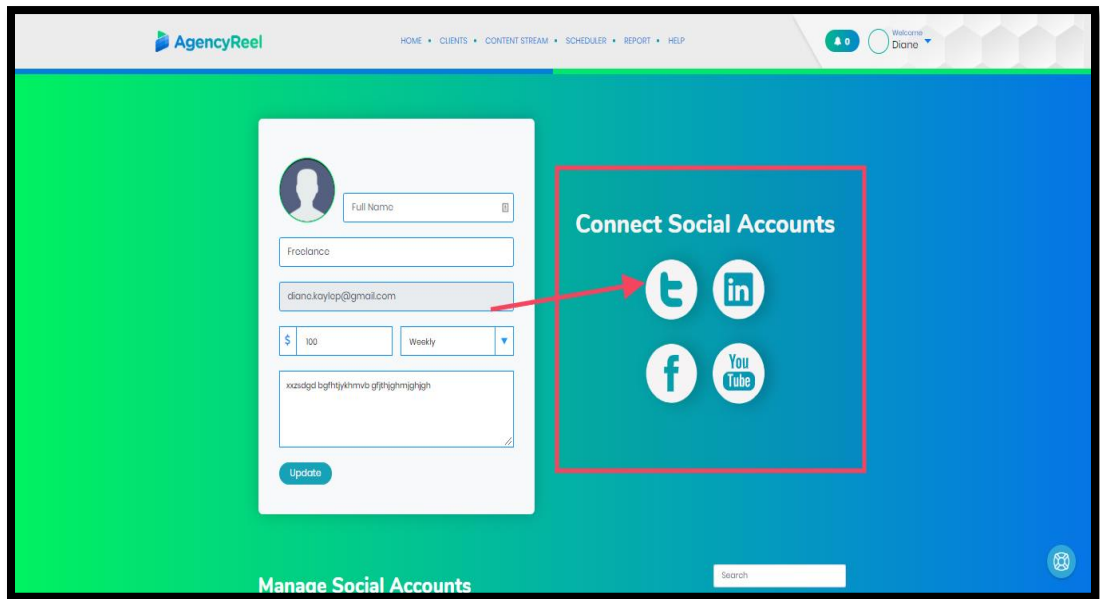
How to Connect Twitter

Connecting Twitter to AgencyReel will let you post your images and videos to your Twitter account.

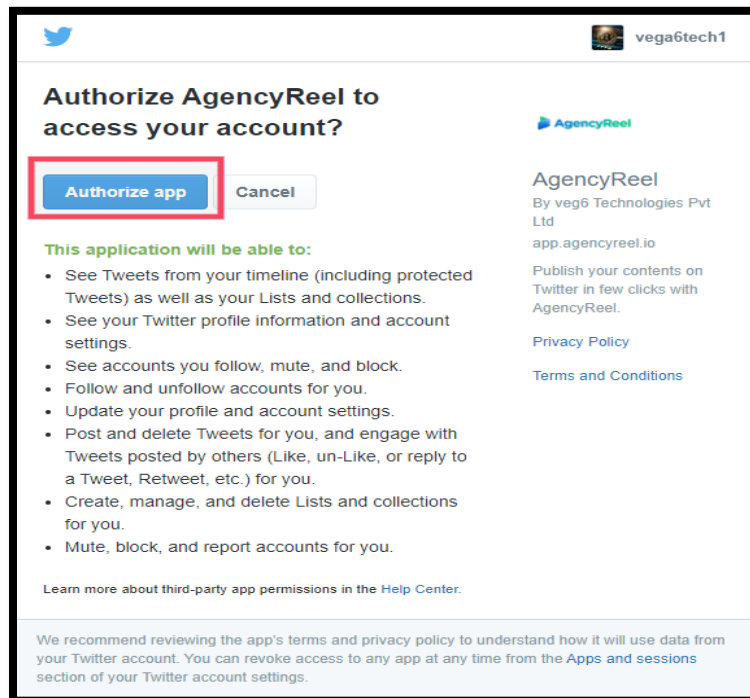
To connect Twitter, click the Twitter Icon.

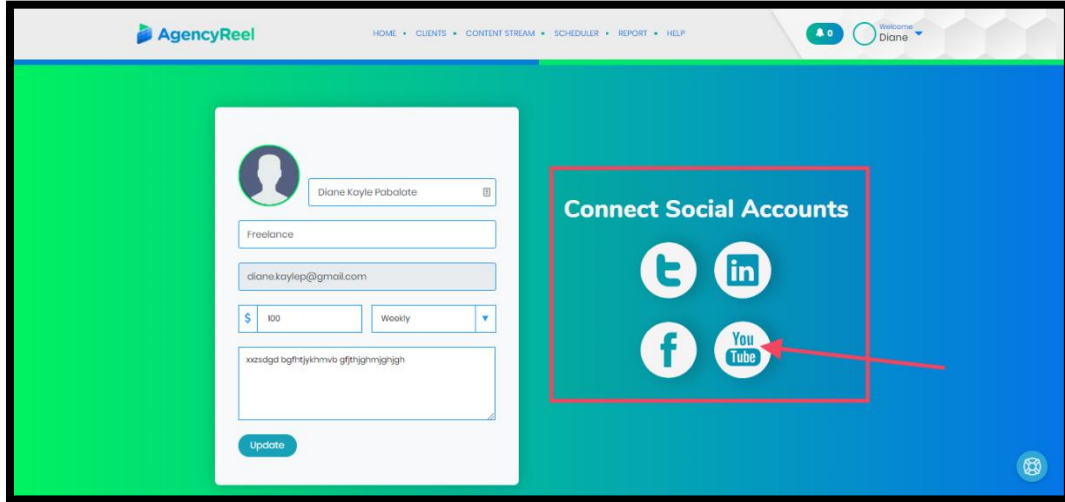
How to Connect YouTube



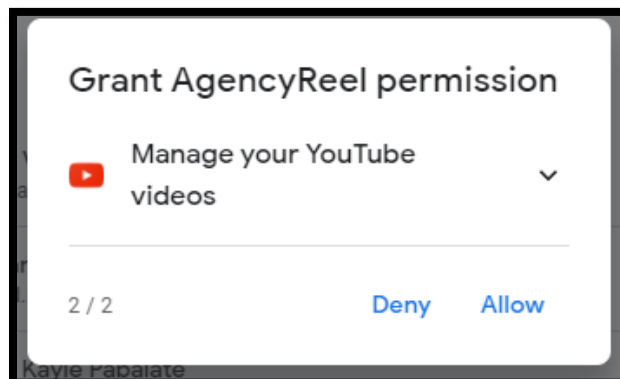
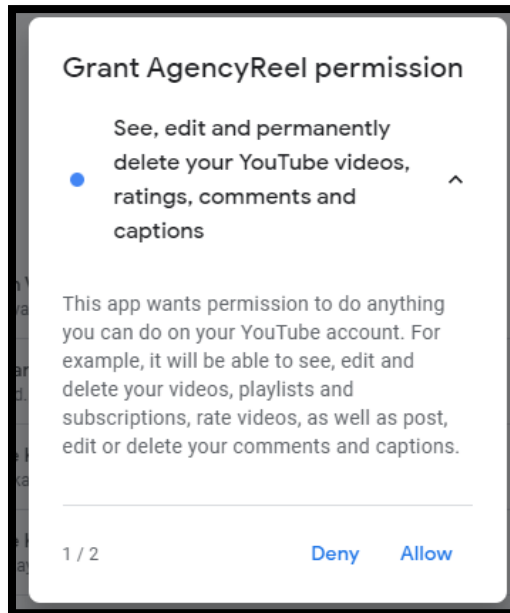

To connect YouTube, click the YouTube icon.

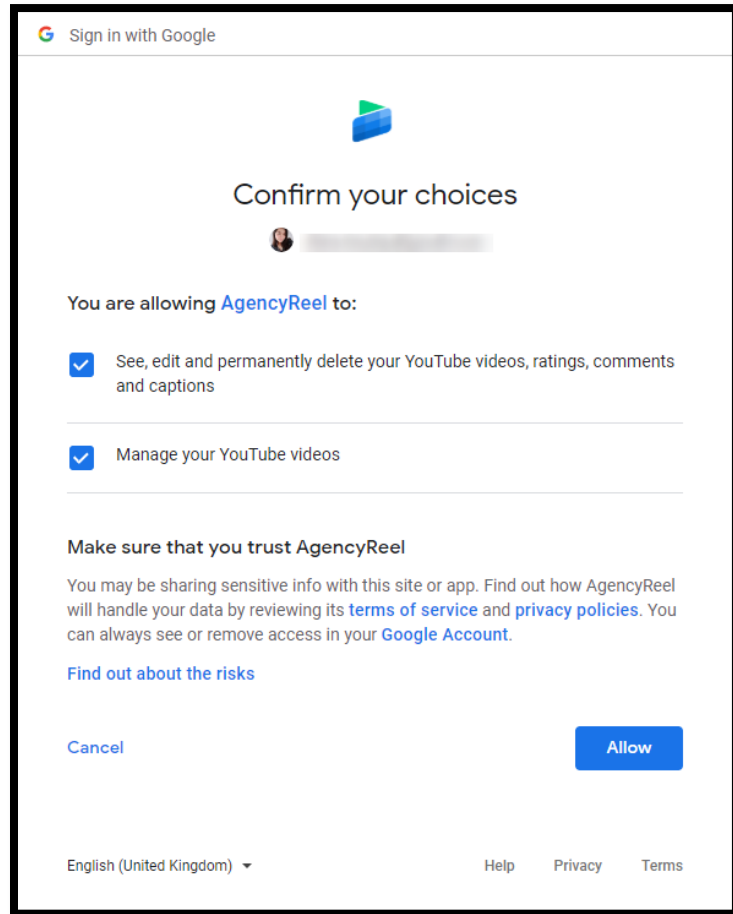


There will be a pop-up asking you to log in to your Google account. Once you've logged in, click on Authorize App to allow AgencyReel to access your YouTube account.
